How are Your Summer Tithes and Offerings?

We wait all year for those "lazy, hazy, crazy days of summer" (as the old song goes), and then many of us are blessed to fill them with vacations that include camping trips or flying to far-off places! It's no wonder that our regular Sunday worship participation dips in the summer.

But while you are relaxing, OSLC continues to be busy with regular worship, Bible studies, caring for sick and the homebound, funerals, VBS, and ministering to others in our community all while planning for our future. And remember the utility bills, insurance, maintenance of our building and grounds, staff, and benevolence still need financial support.

So, here's the challenge: The bills continue to roll in even when you're away on a well-deserved vacation, and many members have not planned to keep their offerings current when they are away.

But here are some ideas that were shared with me by Pastor's Ben Unseth & Robert Blezard for how to help OSLC maintain a positive financial position in these summer months.

Pay it forward: Our Saviour's would love to receive your summer tithes (our first fruits financial commitment to OSLC) and offerings (financial gifts given above the "first fruits" tithe ~ such as for the tuckpointing project), or part of them, in advance. If you know you're going to be away, plan ahead by offering more in the weeks in advance of your time away from your beloved church. Make it up: Alternatively, when you get back from your refreshing time away, give a little more in the weeks that follow in order to make up for the lost weeks.

Use your envelopes: Are you a check-writing person? Then simply fill in advance your offering envelopes with your weekly financial stewardship. If you have a check in every envelope, then on any given Sunday you need only to bring that day's envelope and whatever earlier Sunday envelopes are there.

<u>Use banking bill pay</u>: Many people find online banking services a convenient way to pay their routine expenses. Why not your church tithes and offering as well?

Enroll in electronic giving: We subscribe to electronic giving services, checkout the lower righthand side of our website front page for options, and if you need help enrolling contact the Office. Your tithes and offerings will go right to the church in the amount and according to the timeframe you specify.

Of course, these methods are beneficial not only for the summer months, but also for the whole year! Those who embrace giving as a spiritual discipline often find that their lives of faith are enriched and their sense of joy and fulfillment is deepened. Choosing a regular-giving strategy can help you to discover the joys of generosity as well as keep OSLC stable. Again, I want to thank and recognize Pastor's Ben & Robert for their contribution to this stewardship article.

IMPORTANT FINANCIAL UPDATES

Thank you on behalf of the Stewardship Committee & Council for your continued financial support of OSLC and its ministries. You have stepped up with making offerings (giving beyond the first fruits / tithing) to the recent Tuckpointing Chimney project. This was a greatly needed repair for our church chimney! The work has been completed, but we are still raising funds because: The project total cost was \$16,835. As of June 17, we have raised \$5,625 with \$11,210 left to raise. **THANK YOU** for your past, present, and future financial offerings!

OSLC expenses are being managed but we know these are difficult times with inflationary pressures (repairs, maintenance, utilities, insurance) at a time when consistent Sunday worship participation (especially in the summer months) is traditionally a challenge. General Fund and Benevolence expenses to date (5/31/24) are \$125,235 which is \$16,208 lower than 2023 (in part due to not having a full-time pastor until 4/1/24) and our budgeted envelope/plate offerings are up by \$3,130! We want to keep this valuable information at the forefront as we prepare for the upcoming expenses to Call a new pastor.

To be good stewards and support all areas of ministry including fixed costs such as utilities and staffing, etc., it is important that our tithes (first fruits) and offerings (giving beyond the first fruits / tithing) remain consistent each week/month/quarter. Online and automatic giving is an excellent way to stay current on tithes and offerings over the entire year. Check out page 7 of this newsletter for more information.
